

Environment and Conservation Fund Environment

- Set up in 1994
- Start to have Minor Works Projects from 2008
- Up to now:
 - >460 projects
 - >\$160M approved
- Greening projects: ~\$60M



Eligible Applicant

- Non-profit making organisations in HK
 - Schools and charitable organizations
- Private institutes
 - private kindergartens, ESF and international schools
- All applications should be nonprofit making.



What should be prepared for the application?

- Photos of installation location and floor plans
- Maintenance record of waterproof layers
- Design of greening project
- Quotation for reference






Greening project design plan



Greening Projects – Points to Note

- ✓ Choice of location, roof's condition such as life time of waterproof layer
- ✓ Students' accessibility, fence around the area with height > 2.5m?
- ✓ Adequate space left for users and maintenance staffs after installation
- ✓ Sufficient manpower and time

Vetting Procedure

Application received & supplementary information may be requested if required.

To vet applications in regular meetings of vetting subcommittee

Inform applicant the result generally in 4 months.



Granting Approval from Government Departments

To engage an AP for feasibility study



To assess any change to building structure



To submit the feasibility reports & project details to EDB

Submit plan to BD/ICU of HD for approval (if required)



Plan submission to BD/ICU of HD under Buildings Ordinance required?



end of the collect opinions of other government departments



- EDB notified the school of its approval
- Plan approved by BD/ICU of HD


