Purpose and Introduction

Details of Contest

Website

Hong Kong is a densely populated metropolis. Yet, within this bustling city, numerous picturesque public green spaces are awaiting our discovery and appreciation. With enthusiastic participation in last year's "See GREEN Go GREEN o Travelogue Contest", the Greening, Landscape, and Tree Management Section (GLTMS) of the Development Bureau is glad to present the 2026 edition of the contest, which invite students to actively explore public greening resources of Hong Kong and deepen their understanding of our urban natural landscape.

This year's contest will be in line with the content of the documentary series 森動香港 and the GLTMS's publication "Tree and Landscape Map" to guide students to visit public green spaces, such as parks or waterfront promenades, etc., and create a guided tour travelogue. With both texts and graphical drawings/photographs, students act as tour guide to design a **tour route map** to **highlight the landscape features — including attractions, featured plants and trees within the green space**. Through this contest, students will gain a better understanding of landscape design and greening elements, and appreciate how urban trees and greenery help mitigate climate change, improve our living quality, and support sustainable development.



The **Tour Route Map** shall fulfil the following criteria:



Format: The **tour route map** shall be designed using drawings or photographs, accompanied by textual explanations.



Content: The map must illustrate and introduce the distinctive attractions within the selected green space, including landscape design elements or facilities (such as pavilions, viewing platforms, water features, etc.), as well as featured plants or trees.



Application of Knowledge: The work must incorporate and make reference to at least one landscape design concept or related element as mentioned in the documentary series 森動香港 or the GLTMS's publication, "Tree and Landscape Map".

Judging Criteria

Tour Route Planning	The tour route is planned in a clear and smooth manner, highlighting the key attractions of the selected green space while incorporating personal insights and interpretations of the featured sites.	35%
Composition, Creativity and Design	The composition, use of colour, and overall visual presentation demonstrate creativity and aesthetic appeal. The use of drawings or photographs effectively complements the theme with attractiveness.	30%
Observation and Understanding	The contestants can clearly and accurately introduce at least one landscape design concept or related element as mentioned in the documentary series 森動香港 or the GLTMS's publication "Tree and Landscape Map", and explains how it is applied in the selected site to demonstrate a deep understanding of the concept.	20%
Overall Expression	The text is concise and appropriate with a neat and easy-to-read layout	15%

Terms and Conditions

- i) Participants must carefully read all the information, and terms and conditions of the contest. By submitting the school entry form, the participant agrees to observe and accept all the terms and conditions of the "See GREEN Go GREEN • Travelogue Contest 2026" (the "contest"). The organiser reserves the rights to disqualify participants who violate the terms and conditions.
- ii) There is no limit to the number of entries submitted by each school. However, each individual student may only participate once. If a participant submits multiple entries, their eligibility will be cancelled.
- iii) The organiser will not return the entries to participants after the contest. Participants are advised to make copies for record prior to submission.
- iv) The organiser has the rights to keep and use the entries (in any form, including digital format) for publication, exhibition or promotional purposes, including but not limited to uploading the entries with information including the name(s) of the participant(s) and his/her school onto its website, social media or printed publication, without prior consent of the schools and the participants.
- v) An entry as a whole, including the style, design, composition and content, must be the original work of the participant and must not infringe any rights of any individuals and institutions (including intellectual property rights, non-disclosure agreement or right to privacy).
- vi) All entries must be the participants' original works which have not been published, sold or submitted to other contests. They must also not contain any advertising content for any product or company. Failure to comply will result in instant disqualification from entering the contest and being awarded.
- vii) All entries must not contain any obscene, violent, pornographic, defamatory, indecent, insulting, controversial and inappropriate content.
- viii) The participants' personal data collected will be used only for relevant purposes such as handling competition matters and contacting the winners.
- ix) The personal data provided by participants will be destroyed within 6 months upon conclusion of this contest, excluding the winners' names which will be announced or used for exhibition(s), according to the terms and conditions of the contest.
- x) The organiser has the rights to reject or disqualify any entry without explanation; any dispute will be subject to the final decision of the adjudication panel.
- xi) Should there be discrepancy between the Chinese and English versions of the contest details, rules, terms and conditions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
- xii) The organiser has the rights to amend the rules at any time without prior notice.

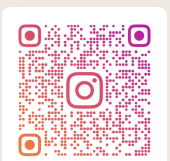
