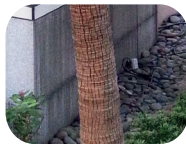

Family: ARECACEAE

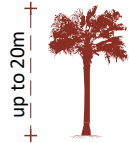
Special Properties: Fruits attract birds to eat; roost site for bats

Special Maintenance Requirements:

Regular pruning of old leaves to avoid fall-off; Pay attention to bats roost on the palm fronds during pruning

Fruiting: Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sep Oct Nov Dec

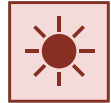

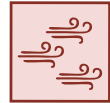

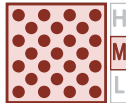
